- ✓ Home to multinationals and IT biggies like Wipro, TCS, IBM, Capgemini, Tech Mahindra, etc



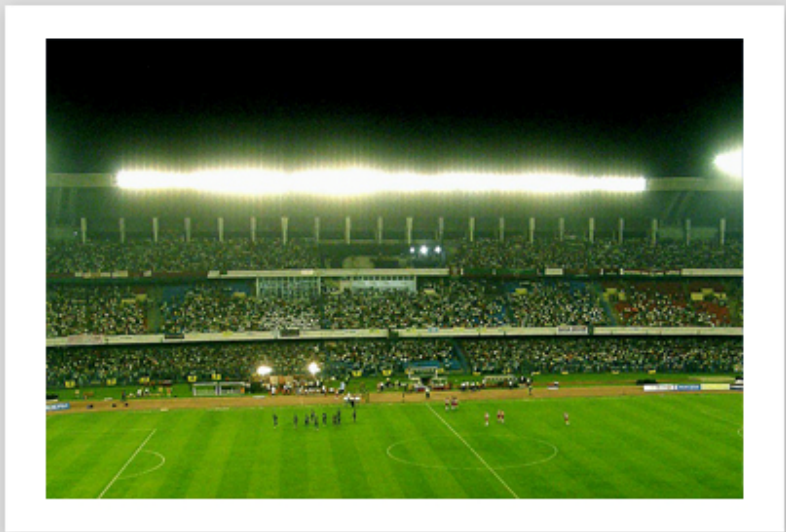
Metro connectivity – A boon for Sector V
